Content/Theme Week: Week 6/OK Go Sandbox

Grade Levels: All Ages

Time Needed: 30 - 60 minutes



MATERIALS

Pencil

Post-It Notes

Crayons

PROCEDURE

- 1 Have you heard of the band OK Go? The Playful Learning Lab at the University of St. Thomas partners with the band to create lessons and challenges based off their videos. Feel free to explore our website:

- 2 First, please watch the “OK Go Sandbox- Flipbooks” part 1 and 2 videos.
- 3 Now that you have watched the video, it’s time to create a flip book.
- 4 You’ll need to take a stack of Post-It Notes (you can use the whole stack, or a smaller amount and save the rest to make a second flip book).
- 5 Start at one end of the Post-It stack, and draw an image. It helps if you start at the back, so you can trace onto the next page. Each time you start a new page, move the image slightly in one direction, so that when you flip through it, it appears to be moving!
- 6 Share your flip book with family or friends!
